


Basma Crop Evolution




- The increase of the green price maintains the production in consistent level

• Even with increased prices, volume decreased and is expected to decrease further, due to the movement of the farmers towards crops with better income for which part of their crop can be sold without official documentation


Greece Total

- The future of Katerini production is uncertain




Prilep Crop Evolution

- Tobacco farmers are supported by the government with national subsidy




Krumovgrad Crop Evolution



- Despite the increased prices, quantity is reduced because Bulgaria is a country with very quick development in the industry and services
- Small farmers prefer to quit tobacco growing and seek employment with permanent and stable income



Izmir Crop Evolution



- Increase in green price in local currency (21.6%) in the 2016 crop coupled with favorable weather conditions had a positive impact on 2017 crop size
- X-Rate has major impact on the export prices

Samsun Crop Evolution



 In the 2016 crop a major increase in TL green price (14.1%) has a positive impact on the 2017 crop size

BALKANS SUPPLY / DEMAND



- Overall there are no significant Oriental tobacco stocks in the hand of the trade in the Balkans
- Illicit trade has a negative impact on the demand on the premium Oriental tobacco varieties
- New Generation Products will possibly boost demand because Oriental tobacco is used



Prospective of Oriental Tobacco



- Long term sustainability of the oriental tobacco production is uncertain in many areas of the Balkans
- The intense manual work and the lack of available labor are putting additional pressure on the crop
- Alternative methods of production are pursued to improve the sustainability of oriental tobacco

Commercial Farming



- Commercial tobacco production with mechanization in all stages of the crop is the future for new big farms
- There is a keen interest by farmers in Greece for comprehensive mechanized production which can be expanded to the other countries that produce oriental tobacco

Crop Mechanization



Transplanting

- -Use improved transplanting equipment which includes silicone based discs
- -Use of laser markers for straight rows
- -Transplanting machine rows to be compatible with new harvesting machines



Crop Mechanization



Hoeing

-Mechanical hoeing between rows minimum two times for root aeration and weed control.

-Third one is done for weed control and ridge creation that will cover sand leaves



COMMERCIAL FARMING



- In the last 4 years, the development of the harvesting machine has made great progress
- As of 2017, the complete mechanization of tobacco production is implemented in 3 regions of Greece
