





### CNCT - FILTERGATE: OPENING OF A PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION



Titanium dioxide proposed to be classified as suspected of causing cancer when inhaled

ECHA/PR/17/10

ECHA's Committee for Risk Assessment (RAC) concluded that the available scientific evidence meets the criteria in the CLP Regulation to classify titanium dioxide as a substance suspected of causing cancer through the inhalation route. The opinion will be formally adopted later by written procedure or at the September meeting.

**Helsinki, 9 June 2017** – The committee assessed the carcinogenic potential of titanium dioxide against the criteria in the Classification, Labelling and Packaging (CLP) Regulation and, having considered the available scientific data, concluded that it meets the criteria to be classified as suspected of causing cancer (category 2, through the inhalation route).

#### RIVM withdraws from tobacco committees

Publication date: 07 May 2018 Modificationdate: 07 May 2018

The Dutch National Institute for Public Health and the Environment will leave the <u>NEN/CEN/ISO</u> committees for tobacco and e-cigarettes with immediate effect. The primary reason for this is the considerable influence the tobacco industry exerts within these committees, whereby safeguarding public health receives insufficient emphasis. RIVM will remain active in other <u>NEN</u>, <u>CEN</u> and <u>ISO</u> committees, which focus on subjects other than tobacco.

<u>RIVM</u> became a member of the so-called tobacco work groups six years ago. Apart from <u>RIVM</u> and the Netherlands Food and Consumer Product Safety Authority, about eight delegates from the tobacco industry participated in the tobacco work groups. This disparity has become more constricting over the years. The <u>WHO</u> Framework Convention on Tobacco Control, which has an important role in Tobacco Discouragement, indicates an irreconcilable conflict between the tobacco industry's interests and those of public health.

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
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Moreover, a new paragraph 4 has been added to the same Article to allow the Minister to draw up a list of prohibited brands of tobacco-based products.




#### Step 1: Drafting Legislative Proposal
