







Antibiotic resistance Is a consequence of heavy use in intensive animal farming systems



Use of Italian hyrid breeds, higher rusticity and better products





Feed rich in long fibers and without 'medical' pellets



Open air rearing systems; cages with intermediate floor



Meat richer in essential fatty acid oils and antioxidants and with lower cholesterol content

Suited to consumers that refuse animal-derived rennet for religious or cultural reasons














... biological detoxification of Ochratoxin A ...

Toxic for liver and kidney, teratogenic, suspected carcinogenic.




