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Wine cellar Italy at 31 December 2021

The Report is drawn up by the ICQRF on data recorded in the wine computerized registers.

The database contains detailed information related to 21,417 registers, **related to 17,364 operators and records about 30 million wine operations annually**. ICQRF estimates that the database contains at least 95% of wine and must held in Italy.

Wines: 61.9 million hectoliters. Compared to the past 30 November 2021 a 19.1% increase is recorded (+10.0 million hectoliters). The stocks are 1,6% higher compared to 31 December 2020 (+948,420 hectoliters).

1. Summary

On 31 December 2021, in Italian oenological premises, there are 61.9 million hectolitres of wine, 9.6 million hectolitres of musts and 2,5 million hectolitres of new wine still in fermentation. Compared to the stocks recorded on 31 December 2020, as reported in table 7, the stocks are 1.6% higher for wines, 16.0% higher for musts and 12.8% lower for new wine still in fermentation. As shown in table 8, compared to the stocks recorded on 30 November 2021, an increase is observed for wine (+19.1%), and, as expected for this period, the stocks of musts (-23.0%) and new wine still in fermentation (-78.5%) keep decreasing.

The 55.7% of wine in Italy is physically stocked in the northern regions, mainly in Veneto region.

The 50.9% of the wine in stock is PDO, 28.1% of wine is PGI, while the varietal wines stocks represent just 1.2% of the total. The remaining 19.8% consists of other wines.

The GIs stocks are highly concentrated; in fact, the first 20 of 526 registered names represent more than half of the total GI stocks (58.4%).

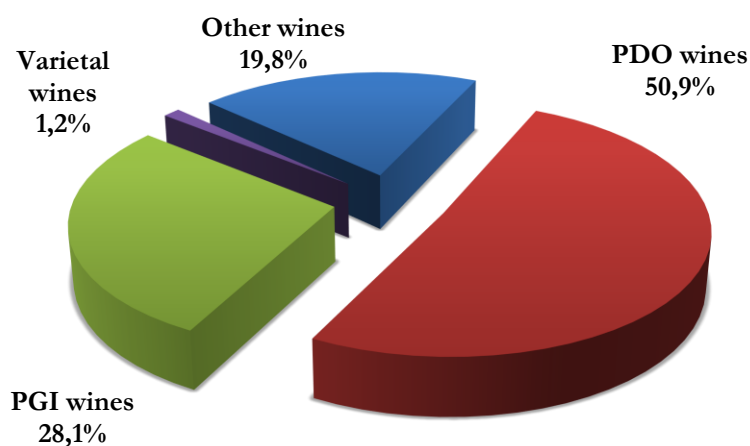
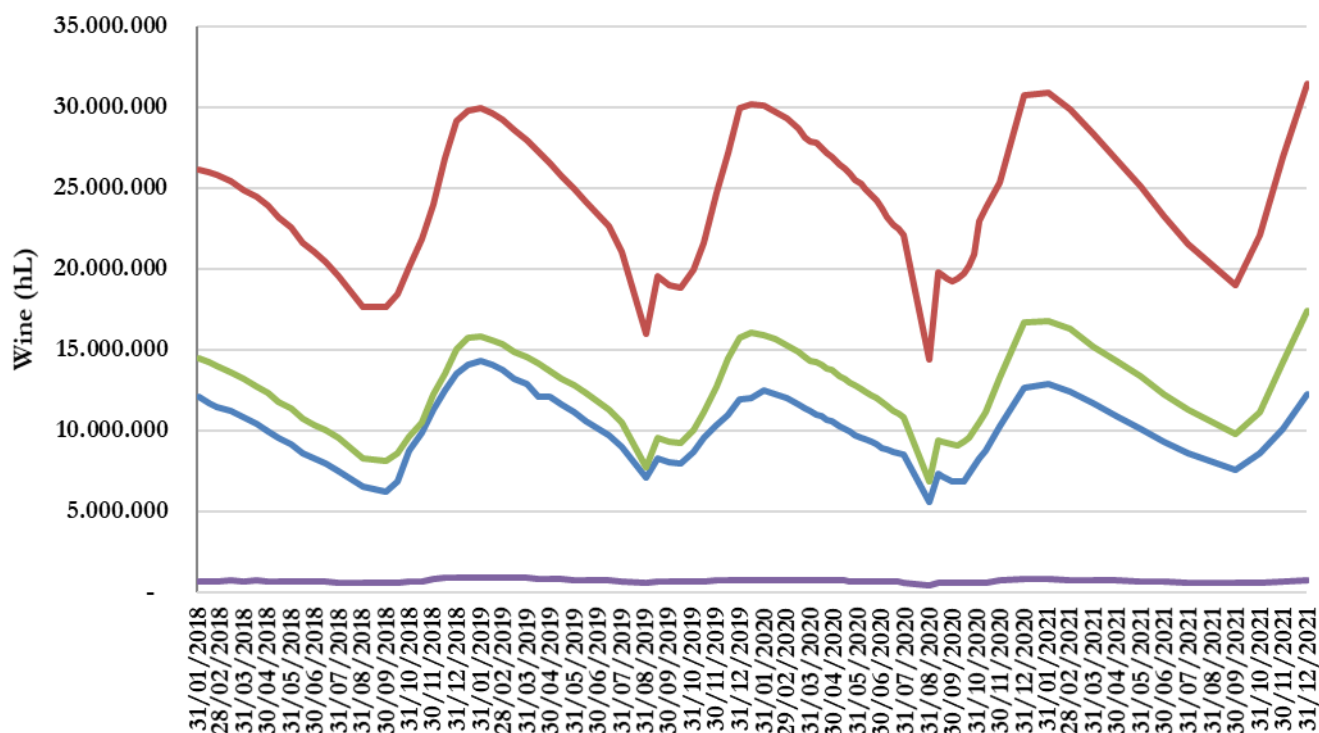


Figure 1. Trend of the wine stocks by category: 1st February 2018 – 31 December 2021



Data at 31 August of each year are influenced by the partial closure of the registrations related to the previous campaigns.

Where is physically stocked the wine in Italy?

The 55.7% of wine in Italy is stocked in the northern regions. In Veneto, there is the 24.1% of the national wine, thanks to the significant effect of stocks in the provinces of Treviso (10.6%) and Verona (8.4%).

Figure 2. Wine stocks by Region and Geographical Area

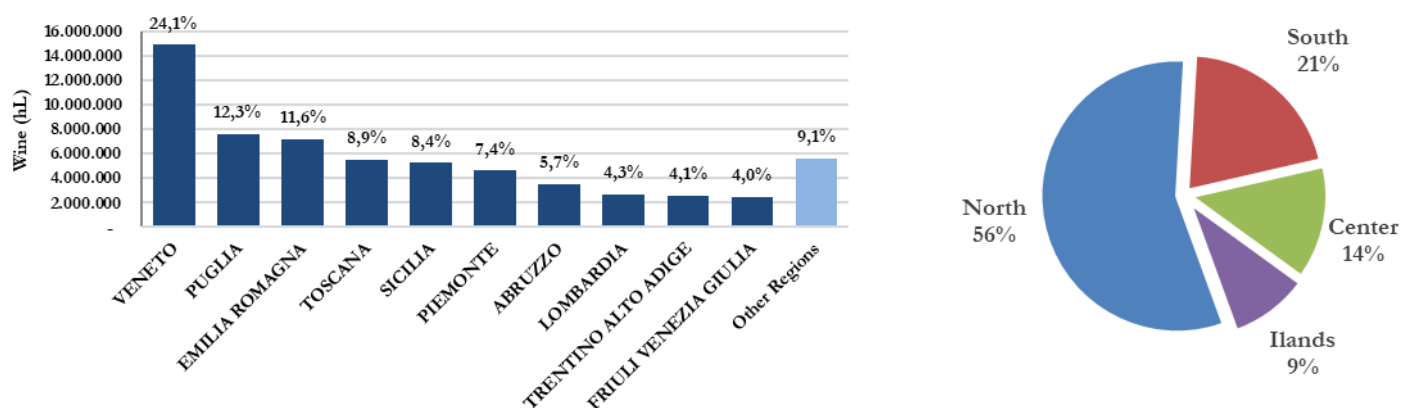

Figure 3. Wine stocks by Province

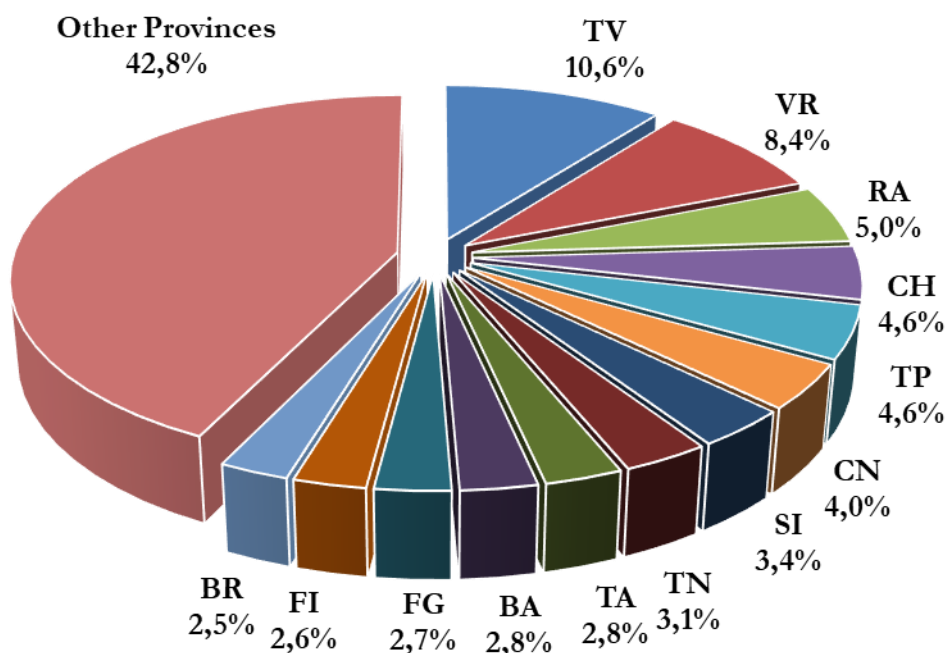

Which wines in the wine cellar Italy?

The 50.9% of the wine in stock is PDO, with a prevalence of white (49.0%). 28.1% of wine is PGI, with a prevalence of red (56.0%), while the varietal wines stocks represent just 1.2% of the total. The remaining 19.8% consists of other wines.

Despite the large number of GIs registered (526), the GIs stocks are highly concentrated; in fact, the first 20 names represent more than half of the total GI stocks (58.4%).

Figure 4. PDO/PGI wines stocks by Region

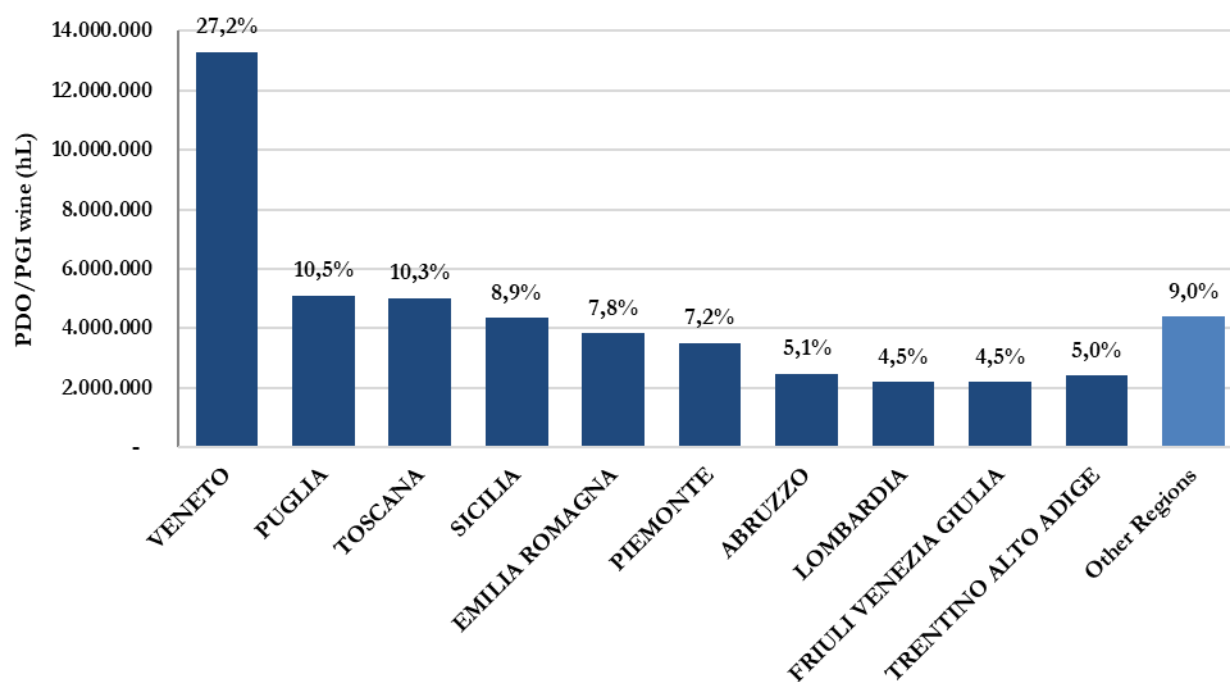
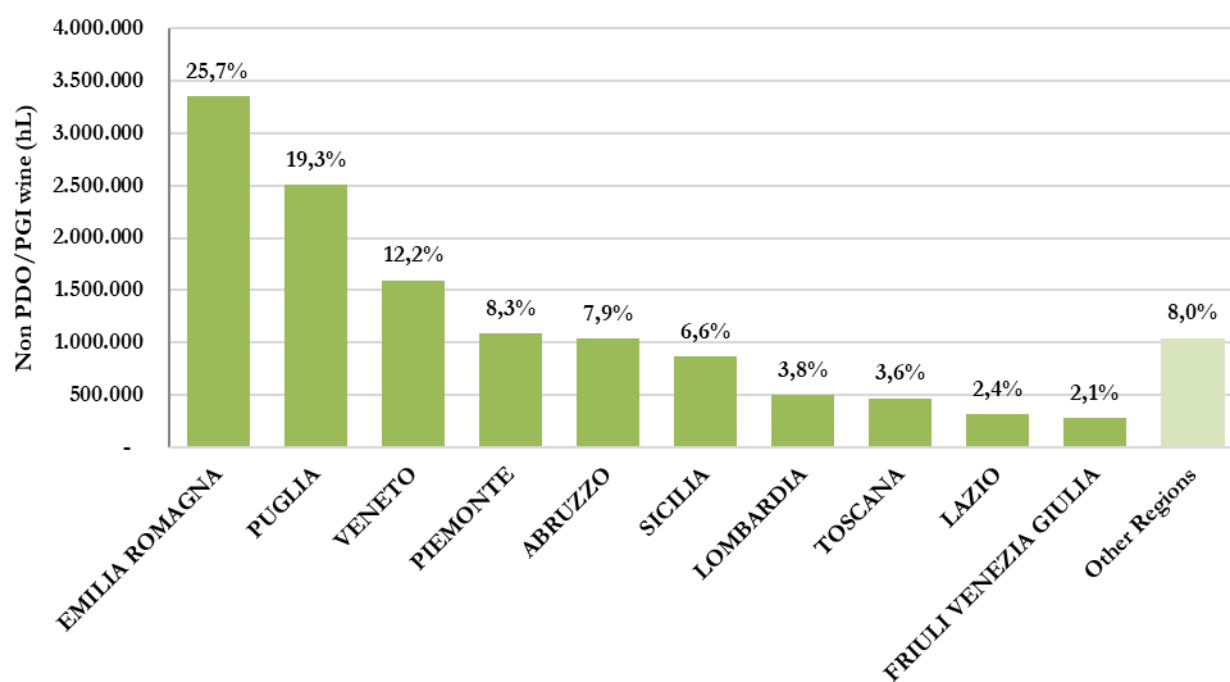


Figure 5. Other wines stocks by Region



3. MUSTS stocked in Italy as of 31 December 2021

Most of the musts are stocked in the southern (48%) and northern (43%) regions of Italy. In the top 2 Regions are stocked the 67.0% of the musts: Puglia (45.1%) and Emilia-Romagna (21.9%).

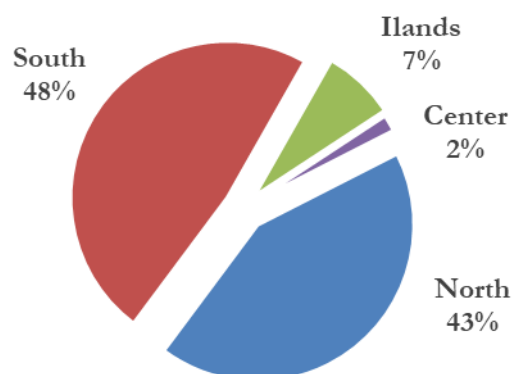
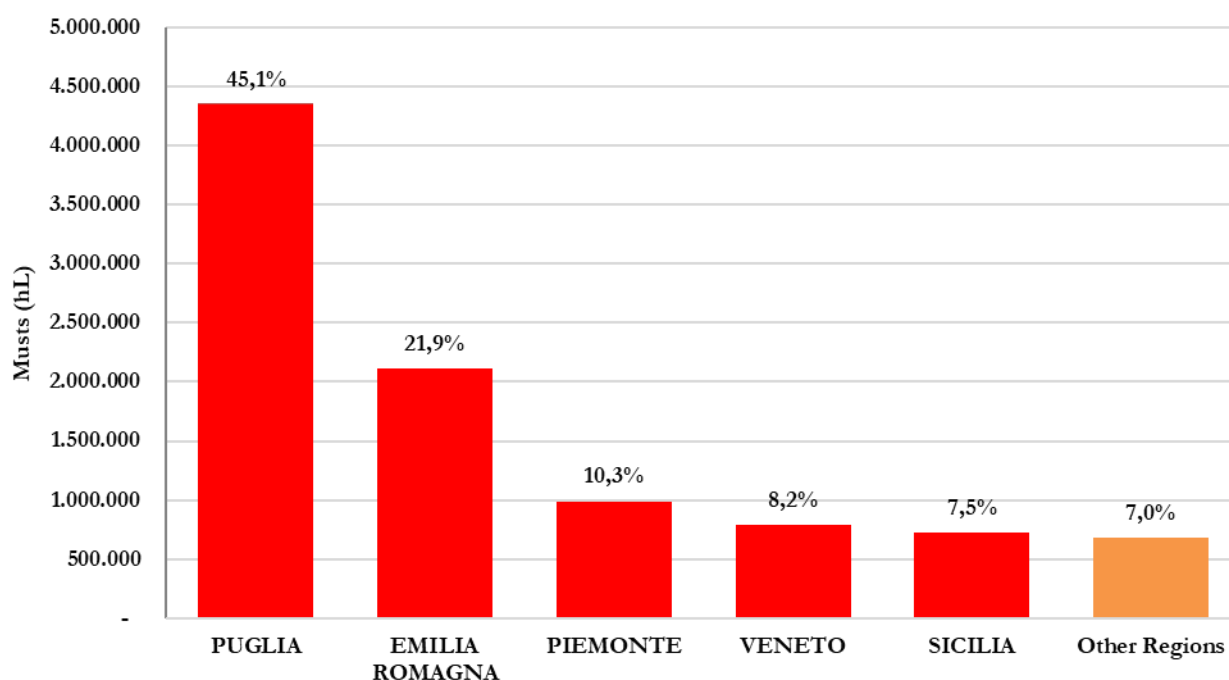


Figure 6. Musts stocks by Region

The new wines still in fermentation are 2.5 million hectolitres, stocked as follow: 34.7% in the South, 34.3% in the North, 27.4% in the central regions, and the remaining 3.6% in the Islands.
